ELIGIBILITY/BENEFITS

To be eligible, participants must:

- Be a U.S. Citizen
- Must have completed requirements for a bachelor's, master's, or Ph.D. within the last 5 years. Some exceptions may apply.
- Undergo an extensive FBI background investigation and meet suitability criteria.
